

Privacy Policy

In accordance with the general data protection regulation of April 27, 2016, hereinafter referred to as GDPR, we hereby inform you that:

1. **EtyAir Virtual Airlines** is the data controller of your personal data.
2. The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer who can be contacted at the following email address: **ceo.etyairva@gmail.com**. You can contact the Data Protection Officer for any matters related to the processing of personal data and the exercise of rights associated with their processing.
3. **EtyAir Virtual Airlines** will process the following personal data:
 - Name, e-mail address, message in contact form,
 - First name and first letter of surname or pseudonym,
 - Email address associated with the crew system,
 - VATSIM network pilot number,
 - Discord username,
 - Data provided during internal training,
 - Rating obtained in the internal training process,
 - Logs from completed flights,
 - Number of completed flights and total flight hours.
4. Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:
 - Recruitment of new members, training process,
 - Membership management,
 - Communication and support for members,
 - Analysis and reporting of operations performed.
5. The legal basis for processing your personal data is Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR - the data subject has given consent to the processing of their personal data for one or more specific purposes.
6. Providing your personal data is voluntary but necessary to participate in the operations carried out by **EtyAir Virtual Airlines**. Failure to provide this data will make membership impossible.
7. Your personal data will be processed on behalf of the data controller by authorized staff solely for the purposes mentioned in point 4.
8. Your personal data will be stored for the duration of active participation in the organization.
9. Your personal data will not be disclosed to external entities.
10. In accordance with the provisions of the GDPR, you have the following rights:
 - The right to access your personal data,
 - The right to rectify your personal data when it is inaccurate or incomplete,
 - The right to erase,
 - The right to object to the processing of your data,
 - The right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority - the President of the Personal Data Protection Office - if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates data protection regulations.
