## §1 EtyAir Virtual Airlines – key information.

**EtyAir Virtual Airlines** – virtual airline operating on the VATSIM network.

**Chief Executive Officer:** Filip Etynkowski.

### **EtyAir Jets:**

**Motto:** Fly Business, Enjoy the World!

**Operational base:** EPWA Warszawa-Okęcie, EPBY Bydgoszcz, HEGN Hurghada.

**Callsign:** ETYAIR/ETYJET

### **Timeline of Events:**

Start of EtyAir Virtual Airlines operations and EtyAir Jets division:

**July 13, 2022, with flight E1 0001 from Warsaw to Marsa Alam on a Boeing 737-700 BBJ SP-QYZ.**

Launch of the website along with CrewCenter:

**November 18, 2023, with flight E1 0084 from Warsaw to Marsa Alam on a Boeing 737-700 BBJ SP-QYZ.**

Welcoming a second aircraft in the EtyAir fleet – Boeing 737-800 BBJ SP-QYY:

**December 31, 2023.**

Start of EtyAir Egypt division operations and first commercial flight of the third EtyAir aircraft:

**March 2, 2024, with flight EJ 3012 from Katowice to Marsa Alam on a Boeing 737-800 SU-EMR.**

Welcoming a fourth aircraft in the EtyAir fleet – Embraer Phenom 100 SP-ETL:

**May 8, 2024.**

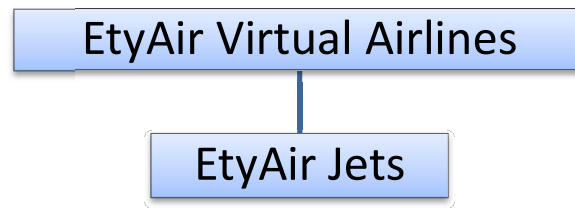
Welcoming a fifth aircraft in the EtyAir fleet – Boeing 777-300ER SP-ETJ:

**June 30, 2024.**

Welcoming another aircraft in the EtyAir fleet – Boeing 737 MAX 8 SP-EJT:

**October 31, 2024.**

The current fleet is available on the website under the Fleet section.

**§2** Structure of EtyAir Virtual Airlines.

EtyAir Jets specializes in charter flights for companies, organized groups, VIPs and ACMI formula.

**The EtyAir Virtual Airlines community is divided into:**

- a) CEO,
- b) Pilots,
- c) Partner Representatives.

### §3 Admission Rules to the Airline

A candidate for the Trainee rank is obliged to complete the registration form on the website [www.crewcenter.etyairva.eu](http://www.crewcenter.etyairva.eu), providing the following information:

- First name and first letter of the last name or nickname, e.g., John W, WelcomeOnBoard, etc.
- Email address.
- Selection of operational base.
- Country of origin.
- Timezone.
- Password for logging into the crew system.
- VATSIM pilot network ID.
- Discord name.
- Express consent to personal data processing by entering the phrase "Wyrażam zgodę" or "I agree" (*I consent*) in the appropriate field.

After successfully completing the form, the candidate may be:

- accepted – in which case they will receive an acceptance email from the airline.
- not accepted – in which case they will receive a non-acceptance email, and their data will be immediately deleted.

If the candidate does not receive any information within a month of submitting the form, it means they were not accepted, and their data has been deleted.

The CEO may, without giving a reason, reject or remove a member from the airline.

#### **Admission conditions:**

- Be at least 13 years old.
- Be a member of the VATSIM network with a minimum flight time of 500 hours.
- Be familiar with systems, manuals (OM/QRH/etc.), and aircraft operation in the fleet to perform operations seamlessly.
- Be able to communicate in English for ATC communication.
- Have an unblemished reputation.
- Adhere to the rules, regulations, provisions of EtyAir Virtual Airlines, and the Code of Conduct of the VATSIM network.

**§4 Pilot Career Path Eanks.**

Requirements for awarding ranks to pilots:

- a)** Trainee - join the virtual airline.
- b)** Second Officer - fly a minimum of 20 hours on any aircraft type.
- c)** First Officer - fly a minimum of 100 hours on any aircraft type.
- d)** Senior First Officer - fly a minimum of 150 hours on any aircraft type.
- e)** Captain - fly a minimum of 250 hours on any aircraft type.
- f)** Senior Captain - fly a minimum of 350 hours on any aircraft type.
- g)** Instructor - fly a minimum of 700 hours on any aircraft type.

Special ranks, given discretionary:

- a)** Chief Instructor
- b)** Partner Representative
- c)** Chief Executive Officer
- d)** Guest (only on Discord server for non-registered members)

**§5 Minimum activity rule.**

- 1) Each pilot must perform at least one flight / one rotation per month.
- 2) In case the requirements are not met, the pilot's account will be marked as inactive – the pilot has 14 days to complete a flight.
- 3) After this period, if the minimum activity requirements are not met, the account will be locked.
- 4) At any time, the pilot may inform about planned longer absence – the rule will be suspended for a time specified by the pilot.

**§6 Rules for Flight Operations**

- 1) Each flight must be conducted within the VATSIM network.
- 2) Each flight must be logged using vmsACARS software.
- 3) In case of vmsACARS program error or malfunction, manual report submission is allowed.
- 4) Adherence to published documents/instructions is mandatory.
- 5) Only one pilot may fly a particular aircraft at any given time. It is not allowed to use an aircraft while it is currently in use by another pilot.
- 6) Transferring an aircraft to a different airport than where the last landing occurred will result in report rejection.

### §6.1 Rules for EtyAir Jets Flight Operations

- 1) When logging into the network, the following CALLSIGN must be used:
  - a) Aircraft registration code. **EXAMPLE: SPQYZ**
  - b) Flight assignment/number (e.g., **E10020 -> ETY0020**): **EXAMPLE: ETY0020**
  - c) Special or event-specific identifier (only with the approval of CEO): **EXAMPLE: ETYGOLD**
- 2) When filing a flight plan, the following must be entered:
  - a) In the OPR field: **WWW.ETYAIRVA.EU**
  - b) If using the ICAO airline code as callsign, in the REMARKS field, enter: **CALLSIGN ETYAIR**
  - c) In the REMARKS field: **PAX CHARTER FLIGHT** or **FERRY FLIGHT**
- 3) Flight Numbers:  
E1 **XXXX** – normal operation (passenger charter),  
E1 **9XXXX** – repositioning flight (ferry).
- 4) Each E1 flight number should be assigned chronologically in relation to the previous one, e.g., if the previous flight was E1**0081**, the pilot should use the number E1**0082**.  
Previous numbers can be checked in the CrewCenter.
- 5) Each pilot, upon acceptance into the airline, is assigned to a specific aircraft from the fleet and is responsible for its operation.
- 6) At the beginning of a pilot's career, they may only fly one pre-assigned aircraft. In further stages of their career, pilots may apply for the allocation of another aircraft.

#### Conditions for applying for the allocation of another aircraft:

- a) Monthly activity exceeding minimums,
- b) Captain rank,
- c) Good standing within the airline.
